

MINUTES:
TAYLOR COUNTY VETERANS SERVICE COMMITTEE:
Meeting of Aug. 28, 2008

Chairman Jim Seidl called the meeting to order at 8:30 A.M. in the West Entrance of the first floor of the Courthouse. Present were committee members George Southworth and Rollie Thums, and Service Commissioners Warren Behling and Barry Anderson.

Mr. Seidl moved to accept the minutes of the last meeting, 2nded by Mr. Southworth. Motion Carried.

Committee member then reviewed the year-to-date activity of the Veterans Service Office and the Veterans Service Commission. The activity reports stood as presented. There were no questions.

The Committee then considered the 2009 budget request for the Veterans Service Commission. Mr. Thums moved to approve the request for \$7,500.00 for 2009, 2nded by Mr. Southworth. Motion Carried.

The Committee considered the 2009 budget request for the Veterans Service Office. The budget request submitted was a no increase budget, and Mr. Thums moved to approve the request, 2nded by Mr. Southworth. Motion Carried.

A discussion was held on the future budgetary need of the Service Office, and how best to approach future needs in light of continuing restricted budgets. Basically these needs will have to be addressed as they arrive, and hopefully the County will be able to meet them.

There being no further business to come before the meeting a motion was made by Mr. Southworth, 2nded by Mr. Thums to adjourn. Motion Carried and the meeting was adjourned at 8:58 a.m.
