1. City of Medford, wards 3&4; In the Court of Appeals race Lisa K. Stark had originally been credited with 134 votes which when canvassed was corrected to show 136 votes for Stark in the City of Medford, wards 3&4.

BOARD OF CANVASS

The Board met in the West Entrance Meeting Room of the Courthouse on Monday, February 25, 2013 at 1:30 p.m. Republican Jon Olson, Democrat Ray Mallo, and Taylor County Clerk Bruce Strama conducted the canvass of the returns of the February 19, 2013 Spring Primary Election for the office of Supreme Court Justice.

The following amendments were made.

1. Town of Goodrich; Two late arriving ballots were included from the MBOC which increased the total number of votes for Ed Fallone by 1 vote to total 4, also increasing the number of votes for Pat Roggensack by 1 to total 22.
2. City of Medford; Late arriving absentees canvassed by the MBOC increased the number of votes by 1 for Pat Roggensack to total 121.
