**RE: Notice of Public Hearing for Annual Low Income Home Energy Assistance  
Program (LIHEAP) Plan**

The Wisconsin Department of Administration (DOA), Division of Energy, Housing and Community Resources (DEHCR), has prepared a draft of the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2022 "Wisconsin State Plan" (the Plan) for the administration of the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). The Plan will be submitted to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services to cover the Federal Fiscal Year October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022. The Plan lists the conditions by which Wisconsin will administer LIHEAP.

DOA-DEHCR will hold a public hearing on August 17, 2021 to accept testimony and comments on the Draft Plan from the public.

Written, including electronic, comments must be received by 1 p.m. on Tuesday, August 17, 2021 to be included in the record of the proceedings.
