**ALL PARTICIPANTS  
MUST REMAIN IN THEIR VEHICLES  
DURING THE CLEAN SWEEP COLLECTION**

Any Taylor County landowner, farmer or household member who has unwanted household or agricultural chemical waste is eligible to participate for **FREE**. *Businesses will be charged a minimal fee*. All businesses must pre-register. Farmers must pre-register agricultural chemicals over 200 lbs. This is to prepare personnel for the anticipated chemicals. It also helps identify any "UNKNOWN" chemicals.

| H.I.D light bulb = \$2.50   |
