**ALL PARTICIPANTS
MUST REMAIN IN THEIR VEHICLES
DURING THE CLEAN SWEEP COLLECTION**

Any Taylor County landowner, farmer or household member who has unwanted household or agricultural chemical wastes is eligible to participate for **FREE**. *Businesses will be charged a **minimal fee***. All businesses must pre-register. Farmers must pre-register agricultural chemicals over 200 lbs. This is to prepare personnel for the anticipated chemicals. It also helps identify any "UNKNOWN" chemicals.

Aerosol Cans (empty cans go in garbage)
Fluorescent/CFL Tubes (first 25 FREE) FARM & RESIDENCES ONLY
Oil-Based Paints ONLY (NO LATEX - latex can be disposed of by drying out & placing in garbage)

UNACCEPTABLE

Latex Paint
Compressed Gas Cylinders
Explosives, Flares, Fireworks
Freon 11 & 12
Vehicle Batteries
Radioactive Materials, Smoke/CO ₂ Alarms
Ammunition
Waste Oil
Appliances
Biological, Infectious or Medical Wastes/Sharps
Recyclables
Electronics
Any Broken Bulbs
Incandescent Bulbs
Oil Filters
Asbestos
Pharmaceuticals

Latex paint can be disposed of by drying out and placing in garbage. Absorbant such as sawdust or kitty litter may be used.

FLUORESCENT TUBES (over 25):
Residential, Farm & Businesses
4' or less & circular tubes = \$1.00
4' + tubes = \$1.50
Shatter shield tube = \$2.50
Tanning bed/UV bulb = \$4.50
LED bulb any size = \$2.00
H.I.D light bulb = \$2.00
