DURING THE CLEAN SWEEP COLLECTION**

Any Taylor County landowner, farmer or household member who has unwanted household or agricultural chemical wastes is eligible to participate for **FREE**. *Businesses will be charged a minimal fee*. All businesses must pre-register. Pre-registration is necessary for agricultural chemicals over 200 lbs. This is to prepare personnel for the expected chemicals. It also helps identify any "UNKNOWN" chemicals.

FLUORESCENT TUBES (over 25):
Residential, Farm & Businesses
4' or less & circular tubes = \$0.75
4' + tubes = \$1.00
Shatter shield tube = \$2.50
Tanning bed/UV bulb = \$4.50
LED bulb any size = \$2.00
H.I.D light bulb = \$2.00

We reserve the right to reject any materials brought to the site that do not meet the reasonable intent of the program.

BATTERIES:
Lithium Ion - \$5/pound
Lithium Metal - \$6/pound
All other batteries - \$1/pound
Pharmaceuticals and Medications:
can be disposed of at the Taylor County Sheriff's Department or at the Aspirus Medford Retail Pharmacy.
