- 1) Owner agrees to file a copy of this contract with **Taylor** County.

- 2) Owner agrees to have the holding tank(s) serviced by the pumper/certified operator licensed pursuant to s. 281.48(3), Wis. Stats., and Chapter NR114, Wis. Adm. Code, and guarantees to permit the pumper/certified operator to have access and to enter upon the property for the purpose of servicing the holding tank(s). The owner agrees to maintain the access road so the pumper/certified operator can service the holding tank(s) with the pumping equipment. Owner further agrees to pay the pumper/certified operator for all charges incurred in servicing the holding tank(s) as mutually agreed upon by the owner and pumper/certified operator.

- 3) Pumper/certified operator agrees to submit reports for the servicing of the holding tank(s) to **Taylor** County, as required by DSPS 383.55, Wis. Adm. Code. A report for the servicing of the holding tank(s) should be submitted on a semi-annual basis. Pumper/certified operator further agrees to include the following in these reports:
 - a. Name, address and registration number of the person servicing the holding tank;
 - b. Name of the owner of the holding tank;
 - c. Location of the property on which the holding tank is installed;
 - d. Sanitary permit number issued for the holding tank;
 - e. Dates on which the holding tank was serviced;
 - f. Volumes in gallons of the contents pumped from the holding tank for each servicing;
 - g. Disposal sites to which the contents from the holding tank were delivered.

- 4) This agreement will remain in effect until the owner or pumper/certified operator terminates this contract. In the event of a change in this contract, owner agrees to file a copy of any changes to this service contract or a copy of a new service contract with **Taylor** County within thirty (30) days from the date of change to this service contract.
